FIRE SAFETY NOTICE - Please read the following information carefully

Fire Service Act 2003, Part 3 Section 18:3 - "It shall be the duty of every person, being on the premises to which this section applies, to conduct himself in such a way as to ensure that as far as reasonably practicable any person on the premises is not exposed to danger from fire as a consequence of any act or omission of his"

In case of an emergency

If you are the first to come across an emergency, please contact reception immediately or raise the alarm by activating the nearest Fire Call Point, if it is safe to do so. A member of the hotel team will then investigate.

Evacuation

When the alarm is activated, the siren will be sounded and then silenced initially while the alarm is investigated. If the alarm siren rings CONTINUOUSLY this is the signal to evacuate the building. Please exit your room in a safe manner. Do not run. Make your way to the nearest fire exit – this is clearly indicated by a green exit sign. If it is unsafe for you to exit, remain in your room and notify reception by telephone. Place damp towels at the base of your door. Your room is protected by a fire-resistant door. The emergency services will evacuate you. From the Fire Exit proceed to the assembly point located directly opposite the front door of the hotel. Please follow the instructions of the staff or the Fire Service.

DO NOT RE-ENTER THE BUILDING UNTIL THE EMERGENCY SERVICES HAVE GIVEN THE ALL CLEAR.
